

FACTS	WHAT DOES SECURITY HOME MORTGAGE ("SHM") DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:  • Social Security number and account balances  • Payment history and transaction or loss history  • Credit history and credit scores
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons SHM chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does SHM protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.

Definitions		
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  Capital Community Bank, Inc. DBA CCBank	
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  SHM does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.	
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  Our joint marketing partners include card issues, insurance providers, and other financial institutions.
